He was named President and Chief Executive Officer in July 2007. He is a member of the company's Board of Directors.

Sadlowski is responsible for all staff functions, subsidiaries and business operations including the Sales organization and five operating divisions: Automation & Motion, Industry Solutions, Power Conversion, Power Distribution & Controls, and Residential Products.

Following 17 years of industry experience with GE and Thomas and Betts, Dennis joined Siemens Energy and Automation in July 2000 to lead the Power Distribution Infrastructure & Controls Division as Vice President and General Manager until the end of 2003. He then relocated to Germany for a three-year leadership assignment with the Automation Sensor Business of Siemens Automation and Drives group before returning to SE&A in 2006 as Chief Operating Officer. As COO, Mr. Sadlowski was tasked with maintaining and ensuring operational excellence and customer satisfaction across all divisions of SE&A.

Sadlowski began his career with General Electric where he held positions of increasing responsibility over a 10-year period. Prior to joining Siemens, Mr. Sadlowski served as Vice President & General Manager of Thomas and Betts, a manufacturer of electrical, electronic, mechanical and utility products.
